RULES FOR:

**SUMMER FUN SCHOLARSHIP BLOW-OUT SINGLES AND
YOUTH/ADULT TOURNAMENTS**

1. Open to all USBC youth members.
2. Youth bowler will use book average of 2016-2017 seasons. If no book average you can use your highest summer league average of 9 games or more as of squad time (**you must have a current standing sheet**).
3. Re-rate of average can or may occur if a bowler averages more than 20 pins over average. Tournament directors will take an average of 24 games on like conditions.
4. **MULTIPE PARTICIPATION:** Multiple participation is allowed, but bowlers may place only once with their highest score.
5. Adult bowler will use book average 2016-2017 seasons. If no 2016-2017 book average you can use 2015-2016 book average. If no book average you can use your highest current summer league average of 9 games or more of squad time (**you must have a current standing sheet**).If no known average exists we will use an assigned average
MEN: 170 & WOMEN: 140
6. There will be 3 divisions in singles: 15 and under, 20 and under handicap & Scratch.
7. There will be 2 division for the Youth/Adult handicap/scratch
8. Age used for the youth will be as of 8/1/2016.
9. Entry fee for the Singles \$10.00 (\$5.00 for lineage & \$5.00 for awards).
10. Entry fee for the doubles \$20.00 (\$10.00 for lineage & \$10.00 for awards).
11. Award fee will be return 100%.
12. Handicap for singles will be 90% to 230.
13. Handicap for doubles will be the combined individual handicaps of 90% of the difference between the average and 230.
14. Squad times are: 10:00 am, Noon, 2:00pm & 4:00pm.
15. **DRESS CODE:** Appropriate clothing must be worn. Skirts and shorts must be no shorter than one (1) hand's length above the knee.
16. Scholarships will be administered to the youth bowlers.
17. Scholarship will be administered by the USBC SMART program.
18. USBC rules apply in any situation not covered in these tournament rules. In cases not covered by USBC rules or published Tournament Rules, the Tournament director reserves the right to make the final decision.
