Qualifying Tournament Rules

Scratch. All Teen Masters (TM) competition is scratch.

Teen Masters Eligibility. To participate in the TM, you must meet the following criteria:

- Student. You must be an active K-12 student whether in public, private, or home school.
- 2.0 Grade Point Average. You need at least a C grade average (2.0 on 4.0 scale).
- Age. You must be born after December 31, 1998.
- Status. You may not be classified as an adult or professional bowler.

Bowling Balls. To level the playing field, participants are limited to the use of one ball. The ball may be polyester with a differential of .020 or less, or non-reactive urethane with a differential of .010 or less. Once practice begins, a player may not change balls unless the ball becomes damaged beyond use. Balance holes less than 0.75" in diameter, grips, plugs and interchangeable thumbs are allowed. Surface may not be changed once scoring begins.

Double Trouble. Teams may be comprised of any two Teen Masters bowlers.

A \$500 scholarship bonus will be awarded to the top female or coed team in Las Vegas! Everyone who enters the Double Trouble qualifying event is guaranteed to bowl. Bring your own partner or find one at the center. Each bowler will roll 1 full game plus 1 game with one member rolling all odd frames and the other all even frames. 3-game totals determine invitation to compete in the \$5,000 DTXL in Las Vegas. Singles Divisions. The Teen Masters offers singles competition in four divisions:

- Teen Masters Boys & Girls Varsity *Includes those graduating in 2018*
- Teen Masters Boys & Girls Junior Varsity *Includes those born after December 31, 2003*

Qualifying Tournament Entry Fees.

- Online, 1 week in advance: Singles - \$50, Double Trouble - \$20
- Online, 1 to 6 days in advance: Singles - \$55, Double Trouble - \$22
- Onsite, day of the event: Singles - \$60 in cash, Double Trouble - \$25 in cash

Invitations to the Championships. The top Double Trouble team will receive an invitation to enter the singles Championships if they also compete in the Singles qualifying on Sunday. The top two bowlers in each Singles division will automatically receive an invitation to enter the Championships in Las Vegas. Additional invitations will be extended on a space available basis. Bowlers have three weeks from the date they earn their invitation to accept it by registering for Las Vegas. *Those needing additional time to register may ask for an extension by emailing registration@teenmastersbowling.com.*

Championships Entry Fee. The entry fee for the Championships is \$275 prior to May 15 and includes two personalized jerseys, 18 to 42 games of competition, credentials, and a ticket to the Welcome Celebration. The entry fee for Double Trouble XL in Las Vegas is \$25 per person.

Refunds. A 10% fee will be charged on refunds. No refunds will be issued after May 15.

Authority. Killer 'B' Promotions will determine any matters not covered in these rules.
