RULES, REGULATIONS AND GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The 2019 Colorado Springs Queens Tournament, supported by the Pikes Peak USBC, is an individual, USBC certified, scratch, double-elimination, match-game tournament. All participants must be female and have a current USBC membership and understand they are competing in a scratch tournament.
 - Participants that have not reached their 18th birthday by March 3, 2019, must have a signed USBC Parental Consent Form (available on BOWL.com) accompany their entry form.
 - Youth Eligibility: If a bowler has a USBC Youth membership they can still maintain their youth eligibility to participate in youth certified competition by signing a USBC Prize Waiver (available on site). Tournament winnings will be deposited in the SMART scholarship program unless the player waives claim to her winnings. Collegiate bowlers should verify prize acceptance policies with their Compliance Offices prior to participating in the competition.
2. **Entry fee is \$85 for entries received by 10:00 P.M. Feb. 27.** Entry fee is \$100 (cash only) for entries received after Feb. 27 (\$10 of the \$15 late fee will be placed in the prize fund and \$5 will go to tournament expenses). Entries close 9:00 am March 3. Entry form and fee must be **received by 10:00 P.M. Feb. 27** in order to be placed in the **early entry cash drawing**. Drawings will be held prior to the start of the 6-game qualifying round. **No personal checks will be accepted after Feb 27.**
3. Check-in for the tournament will begin at 8:30 am. A bowler arriving late will begin play and her score will count beginning with the frame being bowled.
4. Bowlers are requested to wear bowling shirts with their names on the back. Suitable bowling attire should be worn. No tank tops, crop tops, short shorts, short skirts, or leggings will be permitted
5. All bowling balls must meet USBC specifications. Any ball on the USBC approved list (posted on BOWL.com) may be used.
6. Due to time constraints, one lane courtesy will be STRICTLY enforced.
7. If a tie occurs for 8th place or during match play, bowlers shall compete in a 9th and 10th frame roll-off on a pair designated by the Tournament Director. The bowler with the highest single game will select her starting lane. The bowler on the odd lane will start the roll-off. If a tie still exists, bowlers will alternate lanes in a best ball roll-off until the tie is broken. Failure of any bowler to remain available in case of a tie will constitute a forfeit. In the event of a tie for any other position (during the Qualifying Round), the bowler with the highest single qualifying game will be the higher seed. If necessary, the second high qualifying game will be used, and so on down until the tie is broken.
8. *Qualifying Competition Round:*
 - Qualifying Round will consist of 6 games. Lane assignments will be drawn at check-in.
 - Bowlers will be allowed 10 minutes of practice.
 - Total pins will determine the eight (8) bowlers who will qualify for the match play final round.
9. *Match-Play Round:*
 - Lane pairings will be as follows: #1 seed vs. #8 seed; #2 seed vs. #7 seed; #3 vs. #6 seed; #4 vs. #5 seed with the higher seeded bowler selecting her starting lane. Bowlers will be allowed 5 minutes of practice prior to their first match.
 - Two-game double-elimination bracket format will be used. A player is eliminated after two losses.
 - In the event a bowler has earned a break during the competition, she will be entitled to 10 minutes practice on a pair of lanes that is not scheduled for any future match.
10. All USBC Playing Rules and certified Colorado Springs Queens Rules will apply, unless otherwise stated. Tournament Management has the final authority to make decisions regarding anything not covered in these rules.

Refund Policy: Entry fees are non-refundable under all circumstances, including adverse weather conditions. In the event that the entrant is unable to participate, a replacement bowler may be sent. If a replacement bowler cannot be found, no refund will be granted. However, in the case of tournament negligence, necessary monies will be refunded.
