Scholarship to be administered by the USBC SMART Program

PURPOSE: The Greater Denver USBC Youth Scholarship Fund Graduating Senior \$1,000 Scholarship Award, annually recognizes one boy and one girl who exhibit above average qualities in the categories of academics, bowling performance, extracurricular and/or community involvement, and youth leadership.

ELIGIBILITY RULES: Any graduating high school senior is eligible to apply for this scholarship, providing the student meets the following requirements:

- 1) Is currently enrolled and attending a public or private learning institution, or is home schooled, and is due to graduate in the year the application is filed with the Greater Denver USBC.
- 2) Is a current member in good standing with the Greater Denver USBC and is bowling in a USBC certified youth league.
- 3) Completes the application packet, and ensures that the packet, along with any attachments, evaluations and/or transcripts, is turned into the Greater Denver USBC office, or postmarked no later than April 15th, of the applicable year (no faxes – please).

APPLICATION PROCEDURES: The application packet must include at least one reference letter and official school transcripts. Please feel free to add any information that will support your application. All application materials and supporting documents must reach the Greater Denver USBC Office or be postmarked by **April 15th**. Please read carefully and follow instructions exactly. Please type or print answers clearly. Fill out all information completely, using additional sheets of paper, if necessary.
