Scholarship to be administered by USBC SMART Program

PURPOSE: The Greater Denver USBC, proudly continuing the DBA Scholarship Program, for many years, will annually award up to five (5) \$500 scholarships to any high school graduating student or graduate, who is under the age of 23 on **April 15th** of the application year. Applicants may re-apply for this annual scholarship for up to four (4) years as long as they continue to meet the eligibility requirements stated below.

ELIGIBILITY RULES: Any graduating high school student or post high school student, under the age of 23 on **April 15th** of the application year, is eligible to apply for this scholarship providing the student meets the following requirements:

- 1) a current member in good standing with the Greater Denver USBC.
- 2) Has not won this scholarship four (4) times.
- 3) Completes the application packet, and ensures that the packet along with any attachments, evaluations and/or transcripts, is turned in to the Greater Denver USBC office, or postmarked no later than **April 15th** of the applicable year (**no faxes – please**).

APPLICATION PROCEDURES: The application packet must include at least one reference letter and official school transcripts (post graduates may provide internet transcripts). Please feel free to add any information that will support your application. All application materials and supporting documents must reach the Greater Denver USBC Office or be postmarked by **April 15th**. Please type or print answers clearly. Fill out all information in entirety, using additional sheets of paper, if necessary. **Applications should be addressed to: Greater Denver USBC Annual Youth Scholarship Award Program, 99 Zenobia Street, Denver, CO 80219.** Questions may be directed to the office at 303-934-3100.

Step 1 – Fill out application entirely, include at least one reference letter with it, and mail or deliver to the Greater Denver USBC office on or before **April 15th**.

Step 2 – Give the school official/counselor evaluation sheet to your counselor. Ask your counselor to complete the form and mail along with an Official Transcripts to the Greater Denver USBC office by April 15th. Please provide them with a self addressed, stamped envelope. For post graduates, a letter providing similar information would be helpful.

Step 3 – Check with your counselor by March 25th, to make sure the school official/counselor evaluation sheet has been completed and mailed. Thank him/her for their timely submission of the paperwork.

Scholarship winners will be notified by letter from the Greater Denver USBC no later than May 15th.
